## Alabama Bicentennial Educator Workshop Historic Blakeley State Park Tuesday, June 5, 2018 9AM-Noon









This FREE special teacher enrichment workshop held at Historic Blakeley State Park's Wehle Center in Spanish Fort, Alabama is designed to acquaint area social studies and history teachers with two curriculum guides developed for use in schools by the Baldwin County Bicentennial Committee. Both are designed as either single or two-day lesson plans that provide local connections to national

historical events. One focuses on the Creek War and War of 1812 in Baldwin County, and the other focuses on Civil War battles in Baldwin County. Local sites such as Fort Mims, Fort Morgan, and Historic Blakeley State Park are discussed as historical sites and learning resources where events of national importance transpired. Separate presentations have been prepared to meet both 4<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade

curriculums. The 10<sup>th</sup> grade versions feature links to primary resources which may be used in the classroom as supplementary material. We invite area teachers interested in these free learning resources to attend so that project developers can help make them familiar with the content and answer questions. Teachers receive PD credit.
