### **Processing Information**

The content of this collection was received for processing in six 1 cubic foot banker boxes, and a large cardboard box. Most of the items in the boxes were spiraled handbooks and were left as was received. The content did not seem to be in any particular order, so the processor organized the material into boxes according to subject matter. Some of the items were just clipped together so the clips were removed and the items were placed in acid- free folders. Folders were labeled according to subject matter.

# **Biography (Agency History)**

On May 29, 1931, the Legislature of Alabama abolished the form of county government formally known as the Board of Revenue of Baldwin County and established a "Commission form of government." At this time Baldwin County's government became known as the "Baldwin County Commission." The county government is headquartered at the county seat in the City of Bay Minette, where the Administration Building is located. The Commission is composed of four Commissioners, elected by a vote of the entire county, to represent four geographical districts. Each Commissioner is required to be a resident of the district they wish to represent. Further, the county commission employs a county clerk / treasurer who serve as its chief administrative officer in order to affect the policies adopted by the county commission.

Baldwin County, Alabama, is located on the shores of the Gulf of Mexico and Mobile Bay, bordered on the West by Mobile County, Alabama, on the Northwest by Washington County, Alabama, and Clarke County, Alabama, on the North by Monroe County, Alabama, on the Northeast by Escambia County, Alabama, and on the East by Escambia County, Florida.

# **Scope and Contents**

The collection consists mainly of materials received by the Administration building from the departments it maintains. Many proposed projects for Transportation, Waste Management, and Infrastructure Revitalization. It also contains Financial Reports and Budgets, miscellaneous documents, Personnel Policies and Procedures Manual, Environmental issues, and Planning and Zoning materials.
