Does your home have hurricane damage?

The Home Recovery Alabama Program (HRAP) provides housing assistance to eligible single-family owner/occupant applicants (Owner-Applicants) and owners of single-family rental properties affected by **Hurricane Sally** in September 2020 and/or **Hurricane Zeta** in October 2020. HRAP assists property owners by providing funding to repair, reconstruct or replace singlefamily homes that suffered damage from one or both qualifying storms.





Do I meet the requirements?

- Must have occupied the home as a primary residence at the time of the qualifying storm(s)
- ✓ Household is low- to moderate-income
- Applicant must not be in bankruptcy or foreclosure
- Property must not be located in a FEMA-designated 100-year floodplain
- Properties must be unoccupied at the time of application
- Property is located in a HUD- or State-Identified MID County

- Must have owned the damaged property at the time of Hurricane Sally or Zeta. Applicant must still own the property to receive assistance.
- The storm-damaged property must be an eligible structure type
- If there is a mortgage on the property, the mortgage is in good standing
- Property has unrepaired damage from Hurricane Sally and/or Zeta
