- [1] In accordance with applicable State law, and related to the Special School Tax Election District 5 (Am. 382) School Tax District in Baldwin County (Robertsdale, Silverhill, Loxley), Alabama to be held in Baldwin County on September 21, 2021, regarding the Board of Education School Taxes, the Baldwin County Commission will canvass the returns made by the election managers and returning officers and other election officials, and under oath, make a written report declaring the results of said election showing the number of votes cast, both for and against the proposed taxation.
- [2] Approve copies of such reports to be printed in a newspaper published in the county, and for the original reports to be filed in the Office of the Probate Judge.
- [3] In addition, the County Commission will take any other action deemed necessary related to the September 21, 2021, Special School Tax Election and consider and/or authorize any other actions necessary to conduct county business.
