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EARLY NOTICE AND PUBLIC REVIEW OF A PROPOSED ACTIVITY IN A 100-YEAR FLOODPLAIN

To: All Interested Federal, State, and Local Agencies, Groups, and Individuals

This is to give notice that Baldwin County, Alabama, has determined that the proposed Lillian Park Beach Habitat and Shoreline Protection Project is located within and/or may affect a designated 100-year floodplain and will evaluate practicable alternatives to locating the action within the floodplain and the potential impacts on the floodplain from the proposed action, as required by Executive Order 11988, Floodplain Management.

The proposed project is located at Lillian Park in Baldwin County, Alabama, along the shoreline of Perdido Bay. The project consists of shoreline protection and habitat restoration activities designed to reduce shoreline erosion, enhance coastal habitat, increase resilience to storm impacts, and protect public recreational resources. Project activities may include the installation of living shoreline features, placement of protective materials, native vegetation establishment, and related shoreline stabilization measures consistent with permits issued by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and other regulatory agencies.

The project has been developed to address ongoing shoreline erosion and habitat degradation while minimizing impacts to natural floodplain values and functions. Alternatives considered include the no-action alternative and other potential shoreline stabilization approaches. Public comments regarding alternative locations, alternative methods of accomplishing the project purpose, and measures to minimize impacts are encouraged.

There are three primary purposes for this notice:

1. To provide people who may be affected by activities in floodplains an opportunity to express concerns and provide information regarding floodplain resources.
2. To inform the public about potential impacts associated with occupancy and modification of floodplains.
3. To ensure that all interested parties are informed whenever federal assistance is proposed for activities occurring within or affecting a floodplain.

Written comments must be received on or before October 10, 2026, and should be submitted to Baldwin County Commission, Central Annex II, Po Box 220, Silverhill, AL 36576 and (251) 937-0371, Attention: Mark Acreman, PE, Assistant County Engineer.
