## CDBG Three National Objectives

- Benefit to low & moderate income (*LMI*) persons (at least 51%) area benefit (based on Census data) limited clientele (based on survey of households that would benefits or presumed LMI persons which covers abused children, battered spouses, elderly persons, severely disabled adults, homeless persons, illiterate adults, persons with AIDS and migrant farmworkers)

Aid in the prevention or elimination of slums or blight (area or spot basis)

Meet a need have a particular urgency (a.k.a. Urgent Need)

ADECA is required by HUD to expend not less than 70% of CDBG-DR funds for activities that benefit LMI persons, meaning that spot blight and urgent need objectives can only be used for ≤30% of funds.

#### ELIGIBILITY

- Be a CDBG eligible activity (housing or non-housing projects)
- Meet a National Objective, and
- Address a direct or indirect impact from Hurricanes Sally or Zeta


