



Juvenile Detention Center Visitation Expectations

We are happy to provide the opportunity for each family to visit. Below are the expectations and guidelines for being permitted to visit your son/daughter at the detention center.

- Only the Parent/Guardian may visit the juvenile.
 - No more than 2 visitors allowed
 - Everyone must sign in
 - Parents/Guardians may only bring themselves:
 - No Cell phone, Keys, purse, beverages, weapons, money etc
 - Mail will only be accepted through the post office or email.
 - Everyone may be searched and must pass through the metal detector.
 - Voices and behavior should be calm, supportive and appropriate for a small setting.
 - Please do not bring other to wait in the car, or wander around outside while the visitation is occurring.

While your son or daughter is in the JDC they may be on non-privilege level. They will allow you to visit in the **NON-CONTACT** setting:

- Must be scheduled for a 15 minute session from 5:45 to 6:30 on Wednesday and Sundays (in advance)
 - We will make every effort to be on-time, and expect that same from the visitors

Juveniles that have been in the center for 12 days and have not had a major rule violation may be eligible for **CONTACT** visitation. This is a **face to face** visit.

- In order to allow the most visits we have a start and stop time for face to face visits. We expect you to arrive **ON TIME** during your pre-scheduled appointment on Wednesday and Sunday and understand that we have a start and end time. If you are not on time, your visitation may be shorter.
- Please only have conversation with each other, visiting with other residents is not permitted.
- ***All local and state regulations and laws are to be adhered to at all times, or law enforcement may be contacted.***

In order to ensure that the safety and proper supervision of visitation and other juveniles we ask that all families be considerate and follow the expectations. Any violations to the visitation policy may result in or suspension of visitation privileges.
