

The Baldwin County Revenue Commissioner has completed the work of reviewing and adjusting assessed valuations under applicable law and hereby gives notice that the assessed valuations of all property listed for taxation have been fixed as provided by law. The 2020 Property Valuations will be

available beginning April 29, 2020, online at www.baldwincountyal.gov.

The Baldwin County Board of Equalization will sit from June through September 2020 at the Baldwin County Revenue Commission Office (1705 U.S. Highway31 South, Bay Minette, AL) to consider any protests that may be filed by any taxpayer not satisfied with the valuation of their property. Any taxpayer wishing to file an appeal must do so in writing and submit it to the Board of Equalization no later than May 29, 2020. Upon receipt the taxpayer will be contacted by phone or email by a County appraiser. There will be no in-person informal meetings with County appraisers. An appointment for the Board of Equalization hearing will be scheduled if a resolution is not reached in the initial meeting with the County appraiser.
